

EDIX® Treeless


Treeless riding reintroduces the way of riding that was performed for many centuries, before the invention of the treed saddle. Therefore, treeless riding is not a novelty, but a different way of horse riding. Due to the treeless saddle, horse and rider experience more mutual feeling, the so-called "close contact", enabling them to develop easily a more refined way of communicating through the rider's position.

A treeless saddle consists of at least two individual components, and the term "treeless saddle combination" would actually be more appropriate. It is the combination of the special saddle pad, including the pressure-distributing inlays, with the two-part superstructure (the saddle) which together ensure ultimate flexibility across the horse's back. Right there is the strength of the balanced pressure distribution, through the different layers across the maximum surface of the horse's back. It is exactly those soft parts that give the saddle great flexibility in all directions. It goes without saying that your horse will be able to move much more freely because of this enormous flexibility.

















The EDIX® treeless saddles and saddle pads consist of high quality materials which, owing to the structure of different layers of flexible materials, together ensure perfect pressure-distributing properties, the so-called EDIX® MPDS: multiple pressure distribution system. Due to this specific construction, the treeless saddles have the unique characteristics of being able to fully adapt to the anatomy of horse and rider.

EDIX® recommends purchasing a treeless saddle as a package, including stirrups with fenders stirrup leathers and a matching saddle with inlays. In order to ensure constant firm fixation, EDIX® recommends a fully elastic girth.

The EDIX® treeless saddles come in different models and sizes. The EDIX® range offers sizes from 12" up to 19", in diversity, dressage and Western style. The different models are available in the colour combinations brown, black and natural, in synthetic materials or genuine leather.



EDIX® Tequiro

The use of strong quality Nubuck leather makes the complete EDIX® Tequiro treeless Western saddle look sturdier than its little brother, the EDIX® Tiamo model. The EDIX® Tequiro is a very solid and comfortable treeless saddle, equipped with a well-respected type of girth strapping. The girth connection of the EDIX® Tequiro Western saddle is derived from the technique developed by George B. Mc Clellan in 1855. The triangular connection allows the girth force to interact across a larger area of the saddle, as the connections are fastened at the front and the back of the saddle, as opposed to in the



middle. Furthermore, the position of the girth itself can be adjusted forward or backward. As such, only the weight resulting from the interaction of the rider will be at the centre.

The EDIX® Tequiro as a complete combination consists of a 2-part superstructure of high quality Nubuck cow leather and a substructure of a contoured felt saddle pad, including inlays.

A typical treeless saddle for the rider who wants to enjoy long relaxed rides out. Combined with an EDIX® seatcover made of Australian Merino® sheepskin for even more comfortable experience.

An EDIX® treeless saddle offers your horse optimum pressure distribution using the special layers of flexible materials: EDIX® MPDS, (multiple pressure distribution system). These soft, flexible layers adapt to the anatomy of the horse, as well as the rider's posture. An EDIX® treeless saddle optimally reacts to the movements of the horse. Partly due to this, the rider learns to adapt to the horse's movements and, as such, develops an independent position. As a result, the movements of the horse and rider become one, and from there, excellent communication is created. Because the horse is moving much more freely, it has the possibility to develop optimally,

which is often shown by an increase in muscle mass. Due to the above and after the habituation period, both horse and rider, show in all aspect of horse riding more relaxation and more fluid movement.

The pommel is interchangeable and therefore adaptable for a high or low withers. The pommel is made of fiberglass and the cantle is made of the soft material high density foam. They each link the left and right part of the saddle and together they offer stability to the saddle and seating comfort for the rider. Due to the saddle's construction freedom of movement for the spine is created.

By replacing one of the foam layers in the specific EDIX® MPDS structure, through a 14mm felt, the Tequiro has its own individual structure and therefore the Tequiro is also very suitable for the heavier rider.

The complete EDIX® Teguiro treeless western saddle has a matching felt saddle pad including 3 mesh inlays. On the top of the Teguiro pad, left and right from the spinal, there where are the inside inlay pockets are situated, a Neoprene layer has been applied. This neoprene layer gives besides pressure distribution, an anti-slip effect towards te saddle. The abrasive part of the Tequiro pad is reinforced with a suede leather. Due to its own specific shape and the beautiful materials used, the Teguiro saddle pad has a very refined look. If there is a preference for a more Western-like model saddle pad, a different saddle pad can be selected from the EDIX® universal Western pad range. There is the option to choose a felt or a foam guilted saddle pad with an underside that is finished with a synthetic wool or a Australian Merino® sheepskin. Each of these pads ensure freedom of movement for the spine and has the possibility to add exra pressure and position distributing material. Your saddle dealer will be happy to advise

The Tequiro can be combined with the EDIX® saddlebags and breastplate, for which various rings have been fitted. The FRA® supergirth is optional and its 100% elasticity ensures a rock-solid fixation.

EDIX® saddles advises you to buy the proposed treeless saddles complete with substructure (special treeless pad). This to achieve optimal pressure distribution. You will find more information in the extensive EDIX® documentation.

Inlays are subject to wear and tear depending on the intensity of use and need to be checked from time to time for the residual force. These sets of inlays are separately available.

The EDIX® Tequiro western saddle is available in the colours brown and black and in sizes small, medium and large.
